Although we are only in the 3rd week of Lent, Holy Week will be here very soon. Please mark your calendars to attend these very beautiful and meaningful services.

On *Palm Sunday* (March 27/28) we will have our regular weekend Mass schedule.

All services for the *Sacred Triduum* will be held here at Holy Family at 7:30 p.m.

On *Holy Thursday* (April 1) we will have a Pot Luck Dinner prior to The Mass of the Lord's Supper. The pot luck dinner will be in the school cafeteria at 6:00 p.m. There are sign-up sheets in the back of church. Please put your last name and the number of adults and/or children in your group.
